FIRE IN THE HOUSE

Kevin Trout, representing the Line-X facility of Central Ohio, in Columbus, sent in a few photos of this hot '07 Ford F-150 Harley Davidson edition. Brandon Collins applied the real-fire paint, and the Line-X crew added a few extra exterior modifications in the way of Recon LED running lights, bed lights, and a rear 'line of fire' light bar. The spokes of the 22-inch Rockstar 410 wheels have been covered with the same color orange Line-X coating as the bed. A Street and Performance Power Tower throttle-body spacer, a Hypertech Max Energy programmer, and an AEM intake were brought in to extract a few more hp from the engine. All of the modifications made to this truck were done in-house at the Line-X facility, and Kevin would like to stress the fact that their locations can do much more than spray bedliners.



DETERMINED DODGE

Bryan Remolinio, from Cranford, New Jersey, has been wrenching on his '07 Dodge Ram 1500 for almost two years now, but he is nowhere near done with it. So far, he has shaved the factory tailgate spoiler, color-matched the door handles, mirrors, and the factory air dam, and added a SRT-10 hood. A set of 20-inch Rozzi wheels and Cooper Discoverer H/T tires make excellent ground contact while the 3-inch dual after-cat Magnaflow exhaust and K&N intake system help propel the Ram forward. Bryan decked out the interior with a Kenwood in-dash DVD receiver that has been wired up to Boston Acoustics components, a Bazooka bass tube, and a Sony Xplod amp. The truck will more than likely receive a 4/6 drop courtesy of a full air suspension setup soon with a full custom paintjob not too far behind.
